01.	3.4.1	In case the foreign supplier agrees to supply the goods on FCA Gateway Airport/FOB Seaport basis, the consignment will be handed over by Foreign Suppliers to CSP'S Console Agent at the nearest International Airport/Seaport from their premises/works. Foreign Supplier will bear inland transportation charges and all the related charges up to handing over of the material to CSP's Console Agent.	FCA charges will be paid to the CSP in case it is not the International Gateway airport (as per Annexure-I of the bidding document).
02.	3.7.2, 3.10.1 & 3.11.3	<p>The transportation charges will be considered & to be paid on Gross weight as per MAWB/ HAWB/ Packing List.</p> <p>For your kind information transportation is a part of Logistics & the charges for Freight, Handling, Port , Warehousing & transportation are considered & calculated on chargeable/volume weight since chargeable/volume weight is calculated according to dimensions by which transporter comes to the conclusion & finalize the vehicle through which he can deliver the material, so the transportation charges must be paid according to chargeable/volume weight.</p> <p>In the same clauses you have mentioned that the charges of Rs 5000 & Rs 6000 will be paid against Custom clearance, handling, Transportation & other charges etc. but how can any firm transport the heavy material from Seaport to your institute like 20/40 Feet containers. 05.	3.13.4.1	<p>The Hazardous/ Perishables/ Dangerous shipments will be paid as per IATA rates subject to prior declaration by Shipper/ NAL.</p> <p>Please also add ODC (Over Dimensional Cargo) in this clause, since institute is well aware that such type of cargo/shipments also attracts full IATA rate due to its odd sizes/dimensions, subject to prior approval from institute.</p>	ODC shall also be payable as per IATA rates.
